BULLETIN #9 MINISTRY OF EDUCATION K to 12 HEALTH CHECK

To the Pattison High School community

As part of the school's continuing efforts to keep all of us safe, you are reminded to check in daily to the BC Ministry of Education K TO 12 Health Check site as shown:

Download the site to your mobile device and complete the health check survey each morning before you leave for school.
